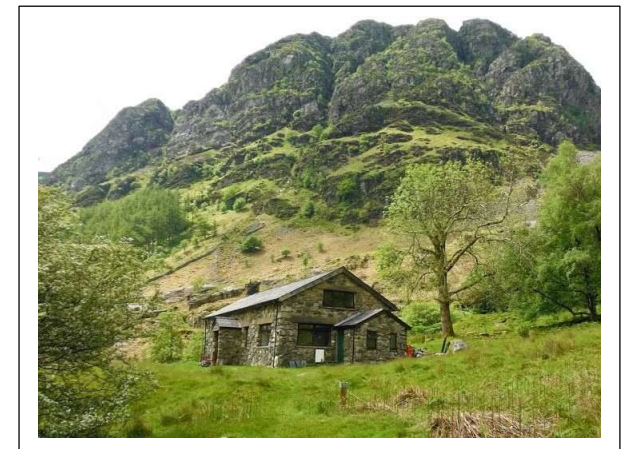

Approach:

The hut is a ½ mile walk from the car park. The path crosses three streams and can, in wet periods, be overflowing with a few inches of water. A torch and good boots are recommended. The section of path just beyond Blaencywarch is also over run by the stream at times.



Positioned near Dinas Mawddwy in the Aran Mountains in the south of Snowdonia National Park, Bryn Hafod provides accommodation for 30 in total, (12 reserved for Club Members only and 18 for visiting clubs). We have reserved 12 places, so have capacity for a few more if needed.

Facilities:

Please check the website for full hut details. It includes a large kitchen, common room, washroom, two showers, drying facilities and an entrance hall.

Note: as is often the case, there is likely to be little or no phone signal at the hut.

Activities:

Climbing: Craig Cywarch (aka Craig Cowarch) is a massive complex cliff-line located above our Club Hut (Bryn Hafod). This vast rambling mountainside, interspersing sheets of rock with towering gullies and heather terraces, will ideally suit mountaineers who can brave the “full mountain day out”, or those who will find the isolated clean walls and revel in some hidden gems.

Walking: Cadair Idris within an hour (by car) and with Y Gribin, Glasgwm and Aran Fawddwy near the hut, there are plenty of options for walkers & runners.

Cost: £26 per person for the weekend, plus optional £2 per trip sustainability surcharge. (Optional Thursday night @ £13 pp bookable in advance by informing the trip organiser and subject to availability).
