BOOKING – please book online yourselves. I have booked pitch 31 which is at the top of the map on the left hand side. The site owner says we can put two small tents and one car onto each pitch, it's the same price but allows us to pitch together and take up a bit less space in the campsite. So if you can car share with someone this will work well. Please share in the whatsapp group which pitch you've booked so we can try to pitch close together. Cost is £58 for Friday and Saturday nights, paid to the campsite, not to the club.

### Facilities

The Campsite has the usual facilities plus a shop and laundry and some on-site food including a new breakfast facility. The site accepts motorhomes/campers and has lots of electric hookups. There are several areas for camping and each pitch appears to be

There is plenty of excellent sea cliff climbing at Swanage – Sport and Trad. Take a look on UKC. In addition there is plenty of walking, beaches and some interesting places to visit including Corfe Castle. The site is a short walk from the coast climbing areas and a 45 minute walk to Swanage beachfront.
