Location:

[Caseg Fraith](#) is in the Ogwen valley 3½ miles north west of Capel Curig, just off the A5 next to Gwern Gof Isaf farm and campsite. Grid ref: SH 68381 60116. What3Words: crescendo.dance.outermost. Latitude/Longitude: 53.1219°, -3.9683°. SatNavs will take you to the wrong location with the Post Code!

Cost for Friday and Saturday nights is £30 plus optional £2 sustainability charge for the weekend.

To book your place please pay your meet fee into our Club bank account, sort code 30-15-53, account 01971285. Please include your name and 'Jun26' as a comment. Email the trip organiser to let them know you have paid.

We'll also look at a communal meal for Saturday if possible.

Facilities

- Sleeping - Three rooms with alpine style dormitories, sleeping up to 46 people. MKMC has booked one of the dormitories (downstairs) at present totaling 20 beds.
- Cooking/Dining – Large kitchen/dining room. Two cookers, two additional hobs, microwave, two larger fridges and a small freezer. All the pots, pans, crockery and cutlery are there.
- Separate ‘snug’ sitting room with a coal fire.
- Sanitation – Three toilets, three washbasins and two showers.

Parking

The hut has limited parking based on their lease with the National Trust. We receive a number of permits based on how many beds we book but there will not be enough parking spaces for everyone. There is usually parking available for a fee in the campsite next door and free parking on the main road. We'll sort out parking once we have a good idea of who is coming and how they are coming but please car share as much as possible.

Activities

Caseg Fraith is in the heart of Snowdonia. The walking in the Glyderau, Carneddau, and Moel Siabod can all be done from the hut without the use of a car. Great Mountain Days Snowdonia Walk Nine passes the door. Buses pass by the hut for point to point walks and you can easily get a bus up to Pen-y-Pas.

There is rock climbing and scrambling everywhere. We are hoping for some great weather to enjoy some of the excellent mountain rounds from the door of the hut over Tryfan and Glyder Fach main cliff. If the mountains are a bit grey then sunshine can usually be found at Tremadog or Holyhead Mountain or Gogarth (Dream of White Horses anyone?).

If the weather is really bad the Beacon Climbing Centre (Big Rock's North Wales sister) is close by and has walls up to 17m! If you would like to go climbing but do not lead climb then please let the organiser know in advance or ask in the meet chat group to find someone to climb with. Be honest about your capabilities it makes for better days out :-)
